Preschool Summer Arts Enrichment Program (for ages 2.5 – 5)

Weekly Rate: (Monday – Friday)

- Full day: \$140 (please bring a lunch; includes optional afternoon nap time)
- Half day: \$100 (consistent day/session required for discount)

Daily Rate:

- Full day: \$30 (please bring a lunch; includes afternoon nap time)

Daily Rate:

Students will work through the rehearsal and production process of learning lines, blocking scenes, and performing song and dance numbers. This workshop pushes the envelope of creativity allowing students to work side-by-side with writer/director Josh James to create and perform an original one-act musical. Every student who registers will have a part in the production!
